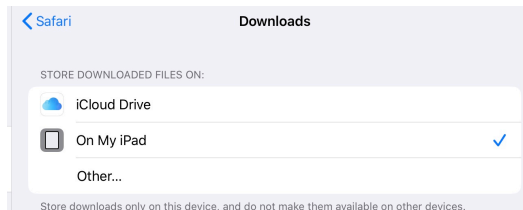


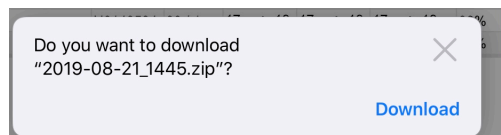
## Downloading assignments with the iPad Filehandler in iOSPad13.

The way Safari behaves in iOSPad13 is slightly different to what happens in previous versions. Returning assignments is unchanged, but downloading is a little different. In fact it's very like the procedure when using the Mac Filehandler, where we navigate to the downloaded file and then import it!

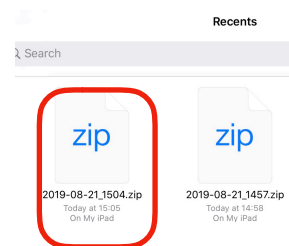
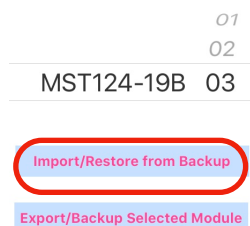
1. As soon as you've updated the OS, go to Settings->Safari-> Downloads and set "Store downloaded files on" to either "on my iPad" or "iCloud Drive" (either will work, but I'd suggest "On my iPad").



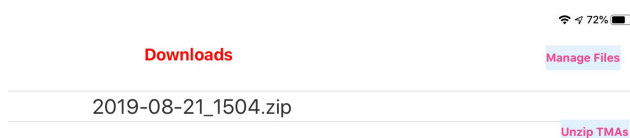
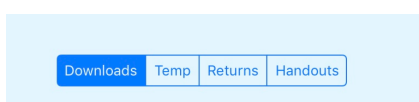
2. When you want to download an assignment, do it in the normal way, except that you won't get the usual "Open in" page when it's downloaded. Instead, you will just be asked to agree to the download. The zipped file will be automatically saved either to your iPad or iCloud depending on how you set it up in Step 1.



3. Now open the Filehandler, tap the ETMAS tab, and tap the "Import/Restore from backup" button. In the dialog that opens, navigate to your downloaded file (looking under "Recents" is possibly quickest). Select it and it should transfer automatically.



4. The zipped file should now be in the Downloads folder on the ETMAS tab in the Filehandler, but it doesn't unzip automatically. Tap Downloads (towards the top left of the screen), select the file



(the date stamp in the filename should help you), then tap "Unzip TMAs". The assignments should then be available, as in the past.

As with so many things, it takes longer to explain than to do.
